### **BRAMSHOTT PLACE VILLAGE RESIDENT MIKE BORROW OBE CONTINUES HIS SUPPORT OF THE POPPY APPEAL**

The Royal British Legion Poppy Appeal began in 1921, and Bramshott Place Village resident Mike Borrow OBE has been supporting it for the last 35 years. This year, as a resident of Bramshott Place Village in Liphook, Hampshire, he is selling poppies to his neighbours and also volunteering as a poppy collector outside Sainsbury's in Liphook.

Mike finds that the Poppy Appeal draws people together "more so than ever before" and his efforts will certainly be making a contribution to the £36 million the Royal British Legion is aiming to raise this year.

Mike has been living at Bramshott Place Village in Liphook for just under a year and finds it "very good indeed." Earlier in his life he was a Merchant Navy seaman, joining at the age of 14 in 1944 and serving until 1950. He was awarded the OBE 25 years ago for services to deep water exploration.
