To become a Pride in the Job winner involves a great deal of commitment and hard work. Judging is based on 38 different elements of project management, from technical knowledge, consistency in the build process to excellent leadership and organisational skills. Only project managers who demonstrate the highest standards in each of these areas receive an Award.

Phase 1 of Bramshott Place Village is now complete, with prices ranging from £295,000 to £315,000 for the apartments and from £435,000 to £470,000 for the cottages.
